 3. Examine the child's achievement and any pending options at the end of the 3rd quarter.
- ✓ Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress as follows:
 1. Weekly newsletters from the classroom teacher,
 2. Mid-quarter reports from the school, and
 3. Quarterly grade cards/reports sent home by the school.
- ✓ Be accessible to parents through:
 1. Phone calls, emails, or person-to-person meetings,
 2. Scheduled conferences before, during, or after school, and
 3. Scheduled school or home visits.
- ✓ Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities as follows:
 1. Listen to children read,
 2. Assist with holiday programs or parties,
 3. Serve on Title I planning committees, and
 4. Help with classroom decorations, art projects, etc.

- ✓ Make sure they are in school every day possible,
- ✓ Check that homework is completed,
- ✓ Provide a quiet place/time to study and provide necessary school supplies,

- ✓ Read with my child daily.
- ✓ Stay informed about my child's education by reading all newsletters and notes from the school and responding appropriately.
