SHAWL MINISTRY: We will meet the third Monday of every month. For more information contact Mary Evans.

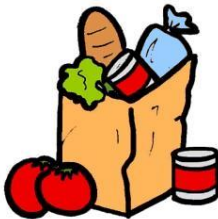


SVDP MEETING: Our next meeting will be this Sunday, October 10th after Mass.
