

**33% of the class of 2024 (24 graduates) attended a 4-year college, 30% attended a 2-year or vocational college, and 33% entered the workforce, 4% entered the military.**

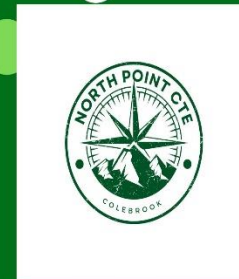
