33% of the class of 2024 (24 graduates) attended a 4-year college, 30% attended a 2-year or vocational college, and 33% entered the workforce, 4% entered the military.

Colebrook Academy administers the school day SAT exam. This exam was given in March to the Junior Class. 8% met both the English and Math benchmarks, 46 % met the English benchmark and 8% met the math benchmark.
