You are applying for a \$1,000.00 educational scholarship funded by the Ebony Drivers of Middle Georgia. If selected, a check will be remitted to the student upon verification of the students' acceptance and enrollment in a university or college or vocational institution. The purpose of this scholarship is to help defray the cost of college. **The applicant MUST graduate with a minimum GPA of 2.5 with verification from the school counselor's office; Submit a one page (minimum) essay detailing how the scholarship will be used, describing planned educational pursuit, and identifying the name of the university or college attending; Submit a Letter of Reference/Recommendation from a high school faculty member, an adult neighbor/friend, an employer, OR a church official (i.e., Minister, Deacon, Pastor).**

The completed application package must be received Not Later Than March 25, 2026.

RULES

1. Applicants must currently attend a secondary school and have permanent residence in Houston County at the time of graduation.
2. Scholarship is open to all Houston County High Schools Students meeting above requirements.
3. Scholarship recipients must enroll full-time (as defined by the institution) at an accredited institution.
4. Applicants can pursue any major field of study offered by the accredited institution.

PROCESS

1. Applicants must submit one original and two copies of the completed application. Each application must include at least one Letter of Recommendation, an Essay, and a GPA verification form.
2. Applicants are responsible for verifying that the EDMG review board has received all application materials. (*See Item 1 above*)
3. After review, the EDMG review board will notify the successful scholarship applicant and the designated educational institution.
4. Upon proof of admission, a check will be issued to that school. The check may be used to help defray any educational expenses, such as tuition, room and board, books, etc...
