Inclement Weather

For inclement weather, SJRCS follows the decisions of Frederick County Public Schools. Any changes in our school day, such as two-hour delay or early dismissal, will be communicated via our Swift Alert system and via text. Additionally, we will post the information on the SJRCS website www.sjrscs.org. As our school families are traveling from numerous areas, please use your best judgment concerning your family's safety. SJRCS has three snow days planned in the school calendar, which are "free" days from school. On the fourth snow day, the students and staff will participate in online learning via Google Meet.

Healthy Habits: A Message from Nurse

Please continue to remain vigilant and monitor the health of the members of your household. We have had cases of COVID, RSV, and Flu reported throughout the school. If a child is exhibiting symptoms of COVID, RSV, or Flu, they should remain home to avoid exposing the school community to illness. Students should also stay home for 24 hours after having a temperature over 100 degrees Fahrenheit, vomiting, and/or diarrhea. 
