**Monday, May 19, 2014**  
**Minutes**

The Randolph County Board of Education met in a regular monthly session on Monday, May 19, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. in the Central Services Board Room, 2222 S. Fayetteville Street Office. Board Members in attendance were as follows: Emily Coltrane-Board Chair, Todd Cutler-Vice Chair, Tracy Boyles, Gary Cook, Matthew Lambeth and Gary Mason. Board member Tommy McDonald was unable to attend the meeting. Also present were Superintendent Stephen Gainey, and the Leadership Team.

**Call to Order**

Emily Coltrane, Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

**Comments by the Superintendent**

The superintendent shared the following: Attended the FFA chartering ceremony at SWRMS.
