### Points of Discussion

#### I. Finalized Budget Updates

- a. How are we post-budget submission? Any changes? Hiring updates? Effects from spending freeze?
  - DCPS has sent regulations about the freeze of spending
  - GPS hired ELA, science, and math teachers. There vacancies are still open. Social worker and bilingual counselor
  - Positions that are vacant for 30 days are subject to be filled by central office
  - Budget has not changed since it was submitted.
  - CSO and WTU positions are opened. Some vacancies are not open yet
  - Restorative justice coordinator position is undecided. The athletic coordinator position requires a master's degree.
- b. How are we with fund raising for seniors?

    1. General Fundraising- \$188.42
    2. Transcript- \$330
    3. Twelfth Grade- \$191.25
    4. Faculty Vending Machine Commission - \$2,702.68
- More fundraising is needed to support senior activities
- Limited budget for decorations, swag, and gifts.

## **II. CTE Micro-Credential Follow up**

- a. Where are we on the status of micro-credentials for our CTE programs? Next steps?
  - Lashes and braiding (currently on pause after central office check current systems and structures of the cosmetology and barbering programs), probably starting next school year
  - The Phlebotomy course will take place after students enroll in the tenacity course
  - These micro-credentials are separate from the CTE courses
  - There will be multiple career pathways
