

DISIPLINE

Foul	Consequence
Before each strike	Warning
1 Strike	Teacher-Student Conference
2 Strikes	Parents will be notified by phone call or ParentSqaure message of student's behavior.
3 Strikes	Parent/Teacher/Administrator Conference
4 Strikes	Referral to Administration for Habitual Class A Behavior

Strikes can be given if students

are: not prepared for class, disrespectful to the teacher or student, talking at inappropriate times, teasing/bullying, inappropriate language, hallway infraction, off task (or disruptive during class times), cheating/lying, not following directions, inappropriate restroom behavior. Students will receive an in-class consequence by the teacher such as silent lunch, silent snack, or reduced brain break.



GRADING POLICY

All subjects will be 60/40.

60%--Major Grades (tests, projects, writing projects, presentations, etc.)
40%--Minor Grades (skills practice, fluency assessments, quizzes, DMR, homework, etc.)



OTHER INFORMATION

- Please read the student handbook. (It's on the the website)
- Students <u>cannot</u> bring fidgets, poppers, spinners, etc to school. They will be taken up until dismissal if students bring them to school.
- Make sure you are at school everyday! You don't want to miss out on all the fun we have in class!
- Parents are not allowed to eat in the lunchroom everyday. We will host Family Lunch Days once each semester.

OTHER INFORMATION

- You may walk in students on the first day of school. Doors will open at 8:00 am.
 Parents will enter through the front doors of the purple hall.
- All student activities and dates will be posted on the school website and ParentSquare.
- All deadlines for turning in money are final.
- · No lockers sales this year.
- The front parking lot is closed until 7:55 each morning. If you are checking in your child, you must park and walk to the front office to check in.

TRANSPORTATION



come later!










