This tentative budget hearing was open to the public and electronically recorded.

The following Board members were present: Mrs. Audrey D. Lewis, Chairwoman; Mr. Leroy McMillan; Mr. Charlie D. Frost; Mr. Steve Scott; and Mr. Tyrone D. Smith. Also present were Mr. Roger P. Milton, Superintendent and Secretary to the Board; and others. Mrs. Deborah Minnis, Attorney for the Board, was present via telephone conference.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The tentative budget hearing was called to order by the Chairwoman, Mrs. Audrey D. Lewis, at 6:00 p.m.

2. PUBLIC HEARING – Tentative Budget and Millage Rate

- a. Approval of Resolution Number 20-01 for the Tentative Millage Rates for the 2020 – 2021 fiscal year

Fund Source: General Fund and Capital Project

Amount: Refer to millage rates and amounts stated on the Resolution

Following Mrs. Lewis reading of Resolution Number 20-01, she stated that the total millage rate to be levied is less than the roll-back rate computed pursuant to Section 200.065(1), F.S. by 4.17 percent. She stated that the Gadsden County School Board adopted each tentative millage rate for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 on July 28, 2020 by separate vote prior to adopting the tentative budget.

The Board unanimously voted to approve Resolution Number 20-01 for the Tentative Millage Rates for the 2020 – 2021 fiscal year following Mr. Steve Scott's motion. The motion was seconded by Mr. Charlie D. Frost.

- b. Approval of Resolution Number 20-02 for the 2020 -2021 Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2020 – 2021

Fund Source: All Funds Budget

Following Mrs. Lewis reading of Resolution Number 20-02, she stated that the budget of the Gadsden County School Board including the millage rates as set forth therein, is hereby adopted by the School Board of Gadsden County as a tentative budget for the categories indicated for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.
