Helpful Hints

-If the vowel is short and no other consonant is heard with the ending /k/ sound in a single-syllable word, the spelling is *-ck* (e.g., *back*; *deck*).

In single-syllable words that end in the letter *s*, *f*, or *z*, the ending consonant is usually doubled.
