

Math greetings to all incoming $5^{\text {th }}$ graders!

I want you to have a super summer and at the same time to keep your math skills sharp so we can start off the 2023-2024 school year strong. The Summer Program is required and will be Two First Quarter QUIZ grades for Math.

## The Summer Math Program will consist of Two parts:

Part 1 (20 points) IXL Summer Boost: Math. You will receive a printed copy of the IXL Summer Boost for $5^{\text {th }}$ grade. There are twenty days of review skills that need to be completed to a MINIMUM Smart score of 90 ( 100 would be even better (3) ). You need to document the date, time spent, and a Smart score for each of the twenty skills. The skills do not need to be completed in order and more than one skill may be completed per day.


## IXL Summer Boost: Math

Part 2 (20 points) IXL Math Action Plan. You will receive a printed copy of your individualized Math Diagnostic Action Plan. Complete the action plan according to the following guidelines:
-Below Grade level or Grade level skill => 90 or above Smart Score
-Above Grade level skill => 80 or above Smart Score
-For every smart score of 100, you earn a bonus point!
*If you work more than 40 minutes (with an appropriate number of questions attempted) and still cannot reach a Smart Score of 80 or 90 , you may scroll down to the bottom of the page and substitute one of the suggested foundational skills.

Additionally, the incoming $5^{\text {th }}$ graders will be entered into the IXL STUDY IN THE SUN contest June 12-August 6, 2023. This contest is OPTIONAL. As an incentive, the top FIVE finishers will receive a 1-point Test Bonus coupon and and IXL Action Plan 1-point bonus coupon! Rules highlights

As your learners practice, please keep these important rules in mind. For more information, read the full contest rules.

- No more than 500 total questions answered (whether answered correctly or incorrectly) per day by a student will be eligible.
- Skills that are repeated after they have been mastered (achieving a SmartScore of 100) once during the contest period will not be counted.
- No more than 50 questions answered by one student in a single skill (prior to reaching a score of 100) will be counted.
- For students in grades PK-4, questions in all grade levels will be counted. For students in grades 5-8, only questions from grade 3 and above will be counted. For students in grades $9-12$, only questions in grade 7 and above will be counted.
