SPORTSMANSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

As member schools of the NORTHEASTERN ARIZONA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (NEAAA), we would like to remind you the objectives of educational based athletics are what set this event apart from all other levels of competition. We have a strong commitment to excellence, fair play, and above all, good sportsmanship. We appreciate your recognition of the values being taught at this educational event.

NEW THIS YEAR: PURPLE CARD POLICY

The official rules allow for an official to give point sanctions to players and coaches for bad behavior during a sporting event. The Purple Card has been added to the officials tools but will be used to address **spectator behavior** during an event.

The 1st issuance of the Purple card will be displayed in one hand. The captains will be called over and the offending spectator will be identified with a team. The **TEAM** will then be issued a warning regarding spectators.

The 2nd issuance of the Purple card during the same event to a spectator from the same team (it does not have to be the SAME spectator that was issued the purple card the 1st time) will result in a Penalty. This will cause the TEAM to be penalized. A point to the opposing team to be awarded and/or a technical will be issued to the team offending. Ejection of the offending spectator, it does not have to be the same spectator.

The 3rd issuance of the Purple card during the same event to a spectator from the same team will result in a ban of any spectator(s). The Purple card will be displayed. The officials and the athletic director will be called to the court, field, table, etc. and the offending spectator will be removed from the site and banned for the season.

In the event of aggressive behavior, defiant behavior, fighting or any other behavior directed towards anyone or deemed unsafe toward others, the spectator will be BANNED from further NEAAA Games for the rest of the School Year. Being a spectator at an event is a privilege - it is not a right. NO ONE may disregard the rules of the facility and the sport, or behave badly at an event.

The NEAAA would like to have parents/spectators and team personnel encourage and cheer for their teams/players in a positive manner rather than have to deal with negative attacks toward our officials, event and tournament personnel, and members of the opposing teams. Unfortunately, we must be prepared for the worst.
