STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS SCHOOL NEEDS

The following strategies will be implemented to address prioritized school needs:

Supplemental Instruction

- o The delivery of Title I funded supplemental instruction will be through
 - Pull Out/Resource Classroom
 - Push In/Regular Classroom
- The supplemental instruction and strategies will be provided in Math and ELA grades 6,7,and 8. Instructional personnel will be certified subject teachers providing the supplemental instruction in reading, ELA, and Mathematics.
 Strategies and instruction will be based on Professional Learning Community efforts and Response to Intervention.
- Professional Learning Communities (PLC)
- Response to Intervention (RTI)

These strategies will provide opportunities for all children, including subgroups of students, to meet the challenging Missouri Learning Standards.

Hamilton Middle School will continue to participate in weekly PLC meetings that employ grade level and vertical team planning opportunities. These meetings afford Title I and regular classroom teachers opportunities to discuss student data, establish SMART goals, as well as develop and modify instructional strategies for struggling learners. We will continue to utilize 3 Title 1 math teachers to offer push-in and pull-out services as well as provide interventions to lower achieving students in the areas of math. We will continue to utilize 3 ELA teachers to provide Tier II reading instruction to struggling readers. We will continue to offer before and after school tutoring and summer school.

These strategies will use methods and Instructional strategies that strengthen the academic program in the school.

All students receive Tier 1 instruction from the classroom teacher. Students will be assessed four times per year through progress monitoring using teacher made assessments. Students scoring below grade level will receive Tier 2 supports from Title 1 teachers. Classroom teachers also support students who are performing below grade level during study lab time to prevent or remediate skill deficits.

The Hamilton Middle School will Increase the amount of learning time by offering summer programs as well as tutoring through our Hornet Building Blocks program

The Hamilton Middle school will help provide an enriched and accelerated curriculum

<u>Students who qualify for enrichment services participate in an enrichment course 3 days per</u> week for 45 minutes while others participate in RTI instruction.

The Hamilton Middle School will provide <u>activities</u> that address the needs of those at risk of not meeting the Missouri Learning Standards.

The Hamilton Middle School will address the needs of all children in the school, but particularly the needs of those at risk of not meeting the Missouri Learning Standards.

All students receive Tier 1 instruction from the classroom teacher. Students will be assessed four times per year and progress monitoring using teacher made assessments. Students scoring below grade level will receive Tier 2 supports from Title 1 teachers. Classroom teachers also support students to prevent or remediate skill deficits who are performing below grade level during study lab time to prevent or remediate skill deficits.

 - Specialized instructional support services
 - Mentoring services

- Implementing a schoolwide tiered model to prevent and address problem behavior, and early intervening services
- Providing professional development and other activities for teachers, paraprofessionals, and other school personnel to improve instruction and use of data
 - Deliver of professional development services
 - Instructional Coach
 - Third Party Contract
 - Professional development activities that address the prioritized needs

Hamilton MIddle School will prioritize trauma informed schools practices and training due to the pandemic closure. We will continue professional development in implementing our new math curriculum series and supplemental web-based support program. We will emphasize social emotional learning discussion during our PLC time as we target struggling learners that will be resistant to remediation.

• Recruiting and retaining effective teachers, particularly in high need subjects.

The district is in a great, rural location. We offer a competitive pay, school affordable insurance plan, and Hornet Building Blocks afford all teachers an opportunity to supplement their income by tutoring students after school hours. The district and surrounding communities are very close and support the multiple district and building programs.
