Consequences for violation of the above rules will be at the discretion of DHS/ MCPSS administrators and could include expulsion from this event and being banned from future DHS events. Also security personnel will be in attendance at all times for the duration of the event.

**Accident Waiver and Release of Liability**

I acknowledge that attendance at Davidson High School Prom is an event that involves risk especially during a pandemic. I hereby assume all risk associated with my or my child's participation in this event. I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability form will be used by the venue and Mobile County Public School District and will govern my actions and responsibilities at this event.

Assumption of Risk - The parent/guardian and student assume any and all risks, known or unknown, which may exist as a result of the student's participation in prom, including, but not limited to traveling to the prom, attendance and participation at prom and traveling from the prom.

Release of Organizers - The parent/guardian and student voluntarily and expressly release and forever discharge MCPSS and personnel from any and all liability, claims, damages, demands, or personal injuries which arise from or are in any way connected to the student's participation in prom, including those allegedly attributable to negligent, reckless, or grossly negligent acts or omissions of MCPSS.

Obligation to Obey Organizers - The parents and students shall abide by and obey all instructions given by DHS staff with respect to the student's participation in prom. The parent and student understand that if the student does not comply with instructions given by DHS staff, the school has the right to remove the student from the event and notify the parent via phone of the student's dismissal. The parent and student acknowledge that they had sufficient opportunity to read this entire waiver. The parent and student fully understand the content of this document and agree to abide by its terms.
