The Frazier School District is taking part in the Pennsylvania School Climate surveys provided by The Pennsylvania Department of Education. The survey asks several questions about school climate and measures three main domains: Social/Emotional Learning, Student Support, and Safe and Respectful School Climate. These free online surveys are intended to provide school teams with data to support improvement efforts. The surveys yield an overall school climate score and subscores in the domains which have been shown, through research, to play a role in student learning and development.
