Dear District School Finance Officers:

Attached is a worksheet that provides an estimate of the fiscal impact on school district and charter school capital outlay funding regarding HB 7037 – School Choice. The bill provides charter school

capital outlay funding equal to the district's 1.5 mill revenue per capital outlay full-time equivalent student or 1/40th the cost of a student station, whichever is less. Because the districts' 2015-16 charter school capital outlay state appropriation is not known, the analysis uses the House proposed charter school capital outlay appropriation of \$100 million. The bill also revises eligibility requirements. The charter schools currently in existence that met the revised eligibility requirements were included in the analysis.

Section 1010.215, Florida Statutes, requires school districts to report certain financial information in the form of a school financial report as part of the annual school public accountability report. The law specifies the contents of the report and requires comparative data at the school, district and state levels. The financial data collected by the Florida Department of Education is available for download by school districts. The school financial report should be distributed to parents by districts as soon as possible, since it is an addendum to the annual school public accountability report issued in August 2014.

#### School Financial Report Items to be Provided by District

Attached is an example of a school financial report. You are encouraged to use this format. Please note that the Operating Costs and the Additional Detailed Information sections present data for K-12 programs only. All adult program cost data have been excluded. The following is a reminder of the data districts must provide for the school financial report:

 Revenue Section – The database transmission will provide the revenue distribution by source for the state and district. Each school's revenue (allocations from the district) must be completed by the district. The intent of the accountability legislation is to inform parents of resources that were available to the school.

Total school expenditures constitute total revenue for the school. Federally funded expenditures are available from the Special Revenue Program Cost Report (including Food Service). Districts should determine the amounts of Educational Enhancement Trust Fund (Lottery) expenditures and privately funded expenditures. State and local shares of the remaining expenditures can be calculated by applying the district-wide state and local percentages.

2. Operating Costs Section – K-12 (Adult costs excluded) – These amounts will be included in the database transmission based on the district's General Fund and Special Revenue Funds Program Cost Reports, except that substitute teachers' salaries and benefits will be included in teachers' salaries and benefits (or in the "Other School-Level Support Services" category), rather than being listed as a separate item. Districts are asked to add a footnote to the section that discloses substitute teachers' salaries and benefits.

- Other objects Not available on database. Districts must provide school and district amounts.
