X-Ray Machine

Year Invented: 1895

One day in his lab, scientist
Wilhelm Röntgen saw a
strange glow on a screen.
He had discovered X-rays.
He found a way to use these
waves of energy to take
pictures of bones and organs
inside the human body.

Slinky Year Invented: 1943

Richard James wanted to invent a spring to keep equipment from sliding around on ships. He accidentally dropped the spring—and it "walked" across the floor. The spring became a toy called Slinky.

Silly Putty Year Invented: 1943

James Wright was trying to create a new kind of rubber. He accidentally created something that was more stretchy and bouncy. It was later named Silly Putty—and became one of the world's most popular toys.
