Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in all programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance.	Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in all programs or activities that receive Federal financial assistance. 34 C.F.R. Part 106	Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in all programs or activities that receive Federal financial assistance. 34 C.F.R. Part 104	Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities. 28 C.F.R. Part 35
