ANADARKO PUBLIC SCHOOLS CORPORAL PUNISHMENT FORM

The Anadarko Board of Education reinstated corporal punishment on June 14, 1993. Corporal punishment will not be administered in the Anadarko School District without prior permission from the parent/legal guardian. At the beginning of each school year, parents or legal guardians will be given the opportunity to sign a statement, either granting or denying permission, for the use of corporal punishment as a disciplinary measure for their child.

Corporal punishment will only be administered as a final effort of corrective action prior to out of school suspension, unless parents/legal guardians request otherwise. Students who do not have a completed corporal punishment form on file, signed by a parent/legal guardian, will be given the option to make contact with his/her parent/legal guardian to request corporal punishment be administered as his/her course of disciplinary action.

If a parent/legal guardian denies the administering of corporal punishment, another form of disciplinary action will be used. Disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to the following: calling the parent to pick the student up from school, taking the student home or to the parent's/legal guardian's place of business, placing the student in In-School Detention, out of school suspension, or assignment to Saturday School. Prior behavior of the student will be the determining factor for course of disciplinary action.
