Midland Varsity Volleyball defeated Grand Blanc 3-2 at home in a 5-set grind on Tuesday night October 1st. The Chemics lost set 1, 21-25, lost set 2, 18-25, bounced back strong to win set 3, 25-10, won set 4 as a team on a mission, 25-18 and then clinched the match in a determined dominating game 5 win, 15-6.

Payton Palmer led the offense with 37 assists, 19 digs, and 3 kills. Nicole Giardina delivered 16 kills, 17 digs while teammate Avery Stewart contributed 14 kills, 6 digs and 2 blocks. Emmalea TerBurgh added 7 kills, 6 blocks, 8 digs; while Brooke Russell added 5 blocks, 4 kills.

For defense, Brigid O'Malley led with 21 digs, 4 assists while Bella Kroll added 7 digs, Rhyannah Nunamaker chipped in 6 digs and Lila Rekeweg dug up 5 digs.

Chemic Volleyball continues SVL play at home this Thursday vs. Mt Pleasant. The varsity record is 18-5 and 5-2 in the SVL.

The freshmen volleyball team defeated Grand Blanc 2-1 last night. The Chemics won set 1 25-18 and set 2 25-20. The team fell short in set 3 in a well fought match with a score of 13-15. The Chemics are 8-2-5 on the season and 4-3 in the league. The Chemics take on Mt. Pleasant this Thursday at home.
