School's Responsibility:

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive, effective environment to meet student academic standards and school goals
- Follow state curriculum standards provided by TDOE
- Build partnerships through a variety of family learning nights (if health guidelines allow) and provide assistance in understanding academic standards, assessments and how to monitor your child's progress
- Provide opportunities for ongoing communication through, at a minimum:
 - Annual parent-teacher conferences
 - Mid-nine week academic progress reports and quarterly report cards
 - The school website, Class Dojo, and social media pages such as Twitter and Facebook
 - Two-way communication between family members and school staff, and to the extent practicable, in a language that is understandable
 - Reasonable access to staff, opportunities to volunteer, and observe classroom activities (as health guidelines allow)
 - Teacher Class Dojo Accounts

Parent's Responsibility:

- Ensure your child attends school on time and regularly
- Encourage your child to show positive school behavior
- Review homework and classwork and offer support when needed
- Monitor your child's social media presence and time spent on electronic devices
- Sign progress reports and report cards
- Attend parent-teacher conferences
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of your child
- Volunteer in your child's school or classroom if time permits (as health guidelines allow)

Student's Responsibility:

- Come to school prepared (whether virtual or in person)
- Complete and return all classwork and homework in a timely manner
- Provide parents with all notices and information received from the school
- Be responsible and respectful at all times
- Ask for help when needed
