What are Title I funds?

- Federal funding provided to educate and improve the achievement level of disadvantaged students.

Who qualifies for Title I funds?

- Schools enrolling at least 40% of children from low income families are eligible for funds that benefit school programs that benefit the education of all students, particularly those with the lowest achievement.
- Fleeta School currently has 84.09% students free/reduced lunch students.

How are Title I funds used to benefit Fleeta School?

Title I funds provide the following:

- a) Additional teacher unit (1 teacher funded at Fleeta)
- b) Technology funding
- c) Instructional supplies
- d) Parental Involvement resources

How does Title I funds assist our public schools?

- Reduces class size
- Provides technology for students
- Funds instructional supplies
- Increases parental involvement
- Increases library resources
- Increases parent resources and copies, etc...
