# PHASE 1 (High / Substantial Spread)

#### Phase 1 (High/Substantial Spread)

#### **Schools are Closed**

- 1. West Carroll Special School District will provide Virtual Learning Academy for all students.
- Expectations for parents and students can be found on the District Website or Google Classroom.
- 3. Ensure provision of student services such as school meal programs.

#### Phase 2 (Moderate Spread)

#### **Visitors**

 No visitors will be allowed in the schools, with the exception of the lobby/office area.

#### **Maintenance by Outside Work**

- 1. Worker(s) that come inside the school building to maintain the facility must have prior authorization from administration. No exceptions.
- 2. The worker(s) will have very limited access to the building and must only work in the designated area that is approved by administration.

#### Assemblies/Programs Before, During, or After School

- There will be no programs during Phase 2.
- TSSAA guidelines will be followed during any athletic events.

#### Masks

• It is highly encouraged but not mandatory for everyone to wear a mask or face shield while in contact with others.

#### **Social Distancing**

Everyone is expected to socially-distance.

#### **Hand Sanitizing**

- Sanitizing stations will be set up throughout the building
- Every classroom has hand sanitizing dispensers
- Students will sanitize hands before entering and leaving an area

#### **Water Fountains**

Hand free bottle filling stations have been installed in all schools.

#### **Cleaning Supplies/Procedures**

 The school will deep clean with hospital grade disinfectants for COVID-19, which includes deep cleaning of all surfaces.

#### **Employee Temperature Checks**

All school employees will have temperatures taken daily.

#### **Beginning of School Day Procedures**

#### **Entering the Building - Beginning of the School Day**

- 1. Students will enter the building and follow the directives of appointed school personnel.
- 2. Signs will be posted reminding students/staff to practice social distancing.
- 3. Students will be directed to a designated area and teachers/staff will take the temperature of each student.
- 4. If the student is manifesting symptoms of illness or has a temperature over 100.0° F, the school nurse will monitor the student and parents will be called for pick up.
- 5. If a student/faculty member has a positive COVID-19 test result, the student/faculty must be quarantined for 5 days from first symptom, and may return on Day 6 if symptom free without use of any medication.
- 6. If a student/faculty member has a positive COVID-19 household contact, there will be no required household quarantines.
- 7. If a student is exposed and asymptomatic, the student will not be required to quarantine.

- 8. Masks are not required but are highly encouraged.
- 9. Bathrooms and all common areas will be disinfected daily and frequently throughout the day.

#### **Breakfast and Lunch**

#### **Delivery of Meals to the Classroom**

- 1. Prepackaged food and beverages will be distributed to each student.
- 2. Students will stay in their classroom during breakfast.
- 3. The students will stay seated at their assigned desk.
- 4. It is recommended that no student bring their lunch from home during this phase.

#### **Cleaning after Breakfast and Lunch**

- 1. Sanitizing stations will be available for student use before meals.
- 2. Social distancing and seating charts will be practiced during meals.
- 3. Meal area(s) will be sanitized before and after meals.

#### **Classroom Procedures**

#### Student Entering/Exiting the Classroom

- 1. Students will sanitize hands when entering and exiting classrooms.
- 2. Desks will be sanitized between classes.
- 3. The students will stay in their assigned seats and receive teacher instruction.

#### **Transition in the Hallways**

- 1. Administration and teachers will monitor students in the hallways during transition.
- 2. Students will walk down the right side of the hallway and face forward.
- 3. Students will observe social distancing.
- 4. Students must keep their hands to themselves and not touch other students or the walls.

#### **Bathroom**

1. The Primary and Elementary schools will have designated bathroom times.

#### **End of School Day Procedures**

#### **Bus Call (End of the School Day)**

- 1. A designee will call on the intercom for buses by number at the end of the school day.
- 2. Students will exit their area in a line (by their bus number) while social distancing.

3. Administration and teachers will have a designated location to monitor and ensure social distancing.

#### Car Rider Dismissal (End of the School Day)

- 1. A designee will call for car riders by intercom to dismiss students.
- 2. Students will be dismissed to the waiting areas while social distancing.
- 3. Administration and teachers will monitor the hallways.

#### Parent/Guardian Dropping Off Student After School has Started

- 1. The parent/guardian will need to wait in the lobby/office area with their student until the Office Secretary can assist.
- 2. The parent/guardian cannot sign the student into school until the students' temperature has been taken.
- 3. The Office Secretary/Nurse will take the temperature of each individual student.
- 4. If the student is manifesting symptoms of illness or has a temperature of 100.0° F or more, then the student will not be admitted to school.
- 5. If the student's temperature is normal and has no manifesting symptoms, the student will be admitted to school/class.

### Phase 3 (Minimal Spread)

#### **Visitors**

• Visitors will be allowed in the schools at the discretion of building administration.

#### **Maintenance by Outside Work**

- 1. Worker(s) that come inside the school building to maintain the facility must have prior authorization from administration. No exceptions.
- 2. The worker(s) will have very limited access to the building and must only work in the designated area that is approved by administration.

#### Assemblies/Programs Before, During, or After School

- All programs will be at the discretion of building administration.
- TSSAA guidelines will be followed during any athletic events.

#### **Masks**

 It is highly encouraged but not mandatory for everyone to wear a mask or face shield while in contact with others.

#### **Social Distancing**

• Everyone is expected to socially-distance.

#### **Hand Sanitizing**

- Sanitizing stations will be set up throughout the building

- 5. If a student/faculty has a positive COVID-19 test result, the student/faculty must be quarantined for 5 days from first symptom, and may return on Day 6 if symptom free without use of any medication.
- 6. If a student/faculty member has a positive COVID-19 household contact, there will be no required household quarantines.
- 7. If a student is exposed and asymptomatic, the student will not be required to quarantine.
- 8. Masks are not required but are highly encouraged.

9. Bathrooms and all common areas will be disinfected daily and frequently throughout the day.

#### Food - Breakfast

- 1. Prepared food and beverages will be provided for each student.
- 2. Students will eat breakfast in the designated areas of their school buildings.
- 3. Students will stay in their assigned seat.

#### Cafeteria - Lunch

#### In the Cafeteria

- 1. The students will be lined up using social distancing.
- 2. Hand sanitizer will be provided to each individual student to disinfect their hands.
- 3. The Teacher/Staff/Cafeteria worker (with gloves) will give students all food trays, food choices, and utensils.
- 4. After staff serves food, the students will collect their food and beverage and be seated and properly spaced according to seating chart.
- 5. Students will remain seated until directives are given to dispose of trash and be dismissed.

#### **Classroom Procedures**

#### Student Entering/Exiting the Classroom

- 1. Students will sanitize hands when entering and exiting classrooms.
- 2. Desks will be sanitized when a child has become ill in class.
- 3. Students will stay in assigned seats and receive teacher instruction.

#### **Transition in the Hallways**

- 1. Administration and teachers will monitor students in the hallways during transition.
- 2. Students will walk down the right side of the hallway and face forward.
- 3. Students will observe social distancing.
- 4. Students must keep their hands to themselves and not touch other students or walls.

#### **Bathroom**

1. The Primary and Elementary Schools will have designated bathroom times.

#### **End of School Day Procedures**

#### **Bus Call (End of the School Day)**

- 1. A designee will call on the intercom for buses by number at the end of the school day.
- 2. Students will exit their area in a line (by their bus number) while social distancing.
- 3. Administration and teachers will monitor the hallways.

#### Car Rider Dismissal (End of the School Day)

- 1. A designee will call for car riders by intercom to dismiss students.
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#### Parent/Guardian Dropping Off Student After School has Started

- 1. The parent/guardian will need to wait in the lobby/office area with their student until the Office Secretary can assist.
- 2. The parent/guardian cannot sign the student into school until the student's temperature has been taken.
- 3. The Office Secretary/Nurse will take the temperature of the student.
- 4. If the student is manifesting symptoms of illness or has a temperature of 100.0° F or more, then the student will not be admitted to school.
- 5. If the student's temperature is normal and has no manifesting symptoms, the student will be admitted to school/class.
