## SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT AT HOME

A way to help your child at home with math is to have them count objects. Knowing how to count to 120 is great, but being able to count and group objects into sets of 10 prepares them for place value. Give your child a group of cotton balls, cheerios, or beads and have them group them by tens and count them. Ask them how many tens and how many ones (leftover pieces). This sets them up for success in place
