

AT School COVID Protocol

2021-2022/ COVID RESPONSE TEAM

UPDATED according to CDC GUIDELINES 12-16-21

- If an individual is vaccinated & experiences a close contact- regardless of symptoms, as well as a negative test = Continues with school.
- If an individual is not vaccinated and experiences a close contact regardless of symptoms as well as a negative test = 5 days out of school. At the conclusion of the 5 days A covid test provided by the school will need to read “Negative” for student or staff to return.
- If an individual receives a Positive Test, no matter what (regardless of vaccination) the whole family and individuals quarantine for 14 days. Must provide validation of a positive test.
- If unvaccinated and is a confirmed positive case, that person must quarantine for 14 days.
- Parents and guardians must call in to report any illness their child may be feeling, so that the school can accommodate that student's needs, while out of school.
(Meals, School work, Attendance)

If a Student becomes ill during the day Instant Isolation in Dorm infirmary

- Instant Screening (with parent guardian permission) - If positive contact trace, as well as immediate quarantine for that individual who tested positive.
- If negative, students will return to class.
- Once the Quarantine Period is over students may return without test results.

Food Services: Must Prepare Meals for Quarantined Students

- Classroom teachers must send a list of students who are quarantined to food service.
- Food service must provide meals to students who are missing due to quarantined.
