## School Counseling Update – March/April 2022

The final quarter of the 2021-22 school year is upon us! It is important for your student to turn in homework on time, have good attendance, and end the year on a strong note. With just a ¼ of the school year left, students should focus on good study habits and review material in preparation for their final exams (worth 20% of the final grade).

### **ONLINE RE-ENROLLMENT FORMS DUE APRIL 15, 2022**

Registration forms can be completed online through ParentVUE. These forms need to be completed by the parent/guardian.. AZ residency documentation also needs to be included with the forms or can be turned in to the counseling office. (Copy of driver's license, utility bill, rental agreement, etc.). **Registration forms are due no later than April 15h so that students may receive their schedule this summer (mailed in July).**

### **SENIOR DEADLINES FOR ONLINE AND MCC CLASSES**

Please note these important deadlines for all classes taken outside of Lake Havasu High School.

May 6<sup>th</sup> : Proof of passing all other online courses due to your counselor. **Official transcript(s) from other school(s) must be sent to the Counseling Office.**

May 13<sup>th</sup>: Unofficial MCC transcript due to counselor. An official transcript **MUST** be provided for all courses taken at MCC that are needed for high school graduation. The transcript can be ordered online here: <http://bit.ly/MohaveTranscript>

### **Summer Options**

There are numerous opportunities available for students to be engaged in activities over the summer. Summer school, athletic camps, academic enrichment programs, employment and volunteerism are just a few of the options that can keep youth engaged during the summer months. Feel free to speak with your student's counselor about specifics beyond what you will see below regarding summer options. Further, you or your student can reach out to our Career Center, where more opportunities are regularly posted and updated.

### **LHHS SUMMER SCHOOL**

Summer School registration forms will be available after Spring Break in the Counseling Office. In order to be eligible for summer school, students must have completed their online registration and cleared all obligations. Summer school will use our SchoolsPLP platform and there will be a requirement to be on the LHHS campus in person. There will be no cost.

Summer school will be held June 1st-29th. This is a great opportunity to open up one extra elective option in the day, get ahead in Mathematics, or catch up with credit recovery! Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders are only eligible to take the SMART Math course this summer.

## **MCC Registration:**

**Mohave Community College plans to host a Senior Registration Night at the Lake Havasu City MCC Campus this Spring 2022. More information will be released once the date is finalized.**

**Current LHHS students that are interested in Dual Enrollment, Concurrent Enrollment, Summer Enrollment, or registration for degree or certification paths through MCC, please speak with your counselor, stop by the Career Center, or contact the Admissions Department through MCC at 1-866-MOHAVECC.**

## **ACT TESTING**

**WHAT is the ACT? ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions throughout the United States. This year, the Lake Havasu Unified School District has been approved to utilize the ACT as our state required standardized achievement test, providing the opportunity for our students to complete the exam for free during school hours to meet district and state requirements, while also simultaneously preparing for college admissions.**

**WHO will take the ACT? Students in 11th grade will take the ACT.**

**WHEN is the ACT given at LHHS? ACT testing will take place in class during the 4th quarter of the 2021-2022 academic school year on April 5, 2022.**

## **Planning for the 2022-2023 School Year**

### **PRE-REGISTRATION IN ENGLISH CLASSES**

**Counselors are meeting with students (in English classes) to select classes for the 2022-2023 school year. Blackboard reminders are being sent out for parents to review their student's selection through Synergy's StudentVue. Students must make all changes, via StudentVue, by April 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**During pre-registration, students were given copies of their graduation status report. Please ask your student about this important information regarding their credits and course selections based on their four-year plan and what they intend to do after high school graduation. If they want to attend a four-year university, make sure that they meet all the requirements.**

**Just a reminder, counselors are assigned based on student last names.**
