April Strevig started the meeting with the pledge. She then opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.

The agenda for the meeting was reviewed. Jodi Short then made a motion to approve the agenda. Tara Hill seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

The minutes of the May meeting were reviewed. Candice Scott then made a motion to approve the agenda. Bobby Jones seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

The minutes of the May teacher election meeting were reviewed. Tiffany Branson then made a motion to approve the agenda. Tara Hill seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Dr. April Strevig gave an update on our School Improvement Plan and Instructional Updates. One of our biggest additions is our GOAL book for all teachers. The GOAL book is a collection of all standards, common formative assessments, data days, and RTI information. Teachers have this and use it at all meetings to collect and discuss data. Jodi Short explained the sections of the GOAL and how teachers are using this to continue to strengthen Tier 1 instruction. Tara Hill discussed being able to use the book daily to make sure we are all on the same page. She also stated that it makes the meetings flow better and keeps everyone on track and focused on instruction.

April discussed the 4 PLC questions that are guiding all of our meetings and decisions made at the school and county level. They are: What do we want our students to learn (Essential Standards), How will we know if each student has learned it (Common Formative Assessments), How we will respond when some students do not learn it (Response to Intervention and Academic Opportunity Time), and How will we extend and enrich the learning for students who have demonstrated proficiency (Enrichments during Academic Opportunity Time).

Dr. Strevig gave an update of our Academic Opportunity Time and how we are managing that at the school level. Our students work within the classroom on their next area of learning. We are also using i-Ready during our AO time to remediate and enrich both math and reading levels for all students.

April did give an update for activities. Principals have been given certain discretion for activities. We will have our first later this month with PAC time with Pre-K. Pre-K classes will

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host PAC time one class at a time with one adult per child as a visitor. At this time, we will not be hosting Thanksgiving/Christmas lunch. We are looking at Field Day and how we can host parents.

PTO is working on making a donation for additional playground pieces.

With no additional discussions, a motion to adjourn was made by Jodi Short. Bobby Jones seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
