5. New Business

- **Carl's Jr. Fundraiser - All Day 10/21 & 10/22** - 48 hour fundraiser, will get 25% of proceeds. Just mention Parkview when ordering.
- **Pie Sales - 10/12 - 10/30** - School will have to order a minimum of 100 pies. Profit is \$6 each, we sell the pies at \$15. Lots of student and class incentives for pie sales.
- **Donor Program -Geared Toward Technology Funding** - Program is geared toward a one time donation in lieu of fundraising.

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- **Proposed Request from District - Park View Fencing** - Fencing location will replace the orange mesh fence at the 2 main entrances. It will include gates and fencing. However, the fencing and gate will not provide a 100% enclosed campus. There would still be unsecure access onto campus in certain areas. Quote from the district is \$24,800. District will pay for most of it but wants PFC to contribute \$10,000 towards it. There is a Recycling budget held at the district that is used for science camp. That budget is \$20,382. Out of that, \$8,000 is earmarked for students who have put in time at recycling, and we will not touch that money. There is still \$12,000 left in that budget and would like to ask the district to take \$10,000 from that fund to contribute to the fencing quote. Some attendees feel the facility cost should be covered by the district. Lots of mixed feelings. Will bring it back at the Nov meeting. Could put a survey together to ask parents for their opinion on the fence.
- **Proposed Request from Mr. Schuller - Mimio Boards** - It turns teacher's white boards into an interactive white board. Would like to buy 17 more boards. The quote came in over \$13,000. There is currently money in the computer lab fund and in the technology fund. The Computer lab will eventually become obsolete in the future. How can we make classes more interactive? The Mimio Teach looks like a power strip. Everything on their computer can be ran from the white board. We currently have 5 Mimio boards on campus. Mrs. McManis used it and fell in love with it. It's a lot cheaper than a smart board. It's a great tool for teachers. Will bring it back at the Nov meeting for a vote.
- **Proposed request from Mr. Schuller - 2 Carts for Existing Chromebooks** - Requesting 2 charging carts, no quote yet but they cost about \$1000 each. Will bring it back at the Nov meeting for a vote.
