1. Welcome and Introductions

Meeting called to order by Mrs. Murrieta at 6:01 PM

Mrs. Murrieta thanked the group for hosting the meeting at the Feast House in Cocklebur Village.

2. Review minutes from last month

a. Title VI Grant 2025-2026

- i. Budget Update –minor updates on the budget were shared. Monies to attend the National Conference, attendance incentive and banquet catering were shared with the group.

ii. JOM Grant 2025-2026

- 1. Field Trip for Attendance- the field trip took place today and the students had a great time at the aquarium. Students who attended had less than 20 days absent from school. Although this still puts some of them at the definition of chronically absent per federal guidelines, it is a decrease from years past. 20 students attended the field trip.

2. JOM Banquet: May 12, 2025

- a. Agenda/Guest Speakers-We have one guest speaker as of now, Dustin LeMaster who is a former Roadrunner student in our JOM program. He graduates in May from VGHS. Dr. Osei is reaching out to Heard Museum to contact another speaker that she has heard before. If anyone in the group has any connections or ideas, they are encouraged to reach out to Ms. Feleys. No ideas were shared at the meeting.
- b. Decorations–Ms. Feleys shared that two teachers have volunteered to decorate for the event and that we would also like each family to bring a traditional/cultural centerpiece for their table.
- c. RSVP #: Ms. Feleys reported that we have 80 attendees so far and can take up to 150. All RSVP's need to be turned in by April 28, 2025 so that catering can be finalized.
