



# Hemingway High School Evening Star Program 2023-2024



## Terms

The Evening Star program is for students who need one or two classes for graduation. Students can earn one high school unit (120 hours).

- The Evening Star program will be located at Hemingway High School.
- Students will have to arrange their own transportation. Transportation will not be provided.
- The length of the Evening Star program is 120 hours. Students will be allowed only two absences from the program, to be made up the day following the last scheduled day of the program.
- If a student misses more than two days, he/she will not receive the credit for the class.
- Classes will be held Monday through Thursday, October 10 –February 22. February 26 will be the only make-up day for the program. There will be no credit recovery classes on the following days, as they are professional development days and school closed:

October 11- Early Release Day for Students

October 19<sup>th</sup> Half Day for Students/Staff Development

October 20<sup>th</sup> No School for Students/Professional Development/Teacher Workshop

November 7<sup>th</sup> District/Schools Closed-Election Day

November 15<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> Early Release Day for Students

November 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> Thanksgiving Break

December 15<sup>th</sup> Half-Day for STUDENTS/Staff Development

December 18 – 29<sup>th</sup> District/ Schools CLOSED/Winter Break- School Closed

January 1<sup>st</sup> District/ Schools Closed/ Winter Break

January 2- No School for Students/ Staff Development

January 3<sup>rd</sup> Students Return to School

February 19<sup>th</sup> No School for Students/Staff Development

- The program will operate from 4:30 A.M. to 6:30 P.M. each day.

## Fees

There is no cost to attend the Evening Star program.

## Attendance

- Each student must be in attendance for 58 of the 60 days.
- Students are allowed only two (2) absences during the entire Evening Star program. The student is responsible for bringing written notification from his or her parent to his or her teacher the day after any absence.
- If a student misses more than two days of the Evening Star program, he or she will be dismissed from the program and will not receive any credit for the course in which the student is registered.
- If a student is more than 15 minutes late to the Evening Star program, he or she will be considered absent from school for that day.

## **General**

- All students must have course approval from the school counselor and principal.
- All students are required to conform to all rules and procedures as outlined in the WCSD 2023-2024 Student Handbook and the Hemingway High School Student Handbook 2023-2024.
- If a student receives more than two (1) discipline referral during the Evening Star program, he or she will be dismissed from the program, regardless of the violation. Student misconduct will not be tolerated for any reason.
- Students are not allowed to remain on campus any longer than 15 minutes after the Evening Star program ends. If late pick-up occurs more than two (2) times for any student, the student will be dismissed from the program.

## **Damaged/Lost Textbooks**

- Every effort should be made to maintain books in the best condition possible. Therefore, students are responsible for the proper care and handling of textbooks. Appropriate fees will be collected if loss or abuse occurs. Students will not be issued any textbook if the student has not remitted payment for a lost/stolen textbook.

## **Dress Code**

- Students are expected to dress appropriately for the educational setting. Attire must conform to the regular school setting. All WCSD dress code policies will be enforced. A dress-code violation may result in a student being dismissed from the Evening Star program.
- State health regulations require that shoes shall be worn at all times in a public school.

## **Automobiles**

- Driving to school is a privilege; therefore, common courtesy, good sense, and caution should prevail at all times. Please be governed by the following rules when using the student parking lot.
  - Cars should be locked at all time for the owner's protection.
  - Traffic regulations are to be observed when entering and leaving the parking lot.
  - Loitering in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. Students must exit their cars immediately upon arrival to summer school. Once school is dismissed, students have no more than fifteen minutes to vacate the campus.
  - If a student chooses to drive to school, ALL PARKING IS AT THE STUDENT'S RISK. The school is not responsible for any damage incurred while cars are parked in the designated parking lot.
  - Drop off and pick up are conducted in the horse shoe at Hemingway High School.
  - Parking in any parking lot other than the one designated by the school is prohibited.

ANY DRIVING/PARKING VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN A LOSS OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES  
AND/OR  
DISMISSAL FROM THE EVENING STAR PROGRAM.

## **Meals**

- Food will not be provided during the Evening Star program. However, there are vending machines available for students if they would like a snack.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the classrooms under any circumstances.
