At the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage of scholars scoring as a proficient or distinguished learner on the GA Milestone Tests will increase by 3%.

STEWART COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL GOAL:

Stewart County High School will increase the percentage of scholars scoring proficient or distinguished on the Spring 2025 Georgia Milestones Assessments, by 3%; while decreasing the number of scholars scoring beginning learner by a minimum of 5%.

- ^Only use my cellphone during the time allowed by school personnel**
- ^Talk with my parents/caregiver daily about my grades and classes monthly**
- ^Do my best on all tests/assessments**
- ^Read daily to improve my reading skills**
