At this time it is set up only for phone and email...not text. Starting next week, we will be sending out notifications to inform you of the process required for text alerts. This will be as simple as giving permission to activate the SMS feature of *SchoolMessenger*. The planned rollout date is set for Thursday, Sept. 19. Please be on the lookout for this request.
