Please complete your transportation preferences online. You may also contact your child's teacher or the District Office. Your child's teacher will review them with you at conference time. If this changes during the year, please let your child's teacher know and contact the bussing company so they are also aware.

Pleasantview:

ALL PRESCHOOL PARENT DROP OFF – Parents may drop off your child at Northwest door (located on Milwaukee Street by the Preschool playground) between 7:35 am and 8:05 am.

3s (Mrs. Buresch Class) PARENT PICK UP - Same location at 10:30 am.

4s/5s (Mrs. Welp's Class) PARENT PICK UP – Same location at 3:05 pm.

Every Wednesday is a 1:30 pm dismissal.

Riverside:

PARENT DROP OFF – Parents may drop off your child at ECFE Entrance off of Springfield Parkway between 7:50 and 8:15 am.

3s AM PARENT PICK UP - Same location at 10:30 am.

3s PM PARENT DROP OFF - ECFE Entrance between 12:05-12:15

3s PM PARENT PICK UP - Same location at 3:00 pm.

4s/5s PARENT PICK UP –Same location at 3:00 pm.

Every Wednesday is a 1:30 pm dismissal.

Community Transit:

Community Transit will be scheduled through United Community Action. Please arrange that by calling Community Transit directly, and then let your child's teacher know that is their mode of transportation.

Palmer Bussing (yellow school bus):

Arrange bussing by contacting Palmer Bus Service directly. No student will be allowed transportation if they are not pre-registered with Palmer Bus Service prior to 9/1/2022.

Preschoolers may ride the route bus if they have an older sibling riding the bus.

If your child is riding the shuttle bus from Pleasantview to Riverside:

In the morning, they will ride bus #5 from Pleasantview to Riverside. Bus #5 also takes the Lakefield K students and there is a paraprofessional on that bus. Your child may choose to ride a different bus if they are with a sibling. The bus departs at 7:45 in the morning from Pleasantview on the west side and drops off at the playground at Riverside.

In the afternoon, they will ride bus #5 from Riverside to Pleasantview. Bus #5 loads on the west side of Riverside and drops off at the playground at Pleasantview. The bus departs at 3:08 pm and arrives at Pleasantview at approximately 3:25 pm.

BUS RULES:

Immediately follow driver directions.

Always sit face forward and do not move from your seat.

Talk quietly and use appropriate language.

Keep all body parts inside of the bus.

Keep your hands, arms, and belongings to yourself.

No fighting, shoving, pushing or horseplay.

No eating or drinking on the bus

No matches, lighters, tobacco or electronic cigarettes allowed on the bus.

No harassment allowed.

Discipline procedures on the bus:

First offense: verbal warning, call to parent and school principal

Second offense: Student is placed in front seat for 2 weeks, call to parent and school principal

Third offense: Student is denied transportation for 5-10 days depending on the severity of the offense, call to parent and principal

Palmer Bus reserves the right to deny school bus transportation to a student after the first offense, depending on the severity of the incident.
