## Sumter Central High School Credit Recovery & Credit Obtainment Program Summer 2024

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: A Summer Credit Recovery/Obtainment Program is available for students currently enrolled in grades 9-12 in the Sumter County School System. Courses may be offered online and/or face-to-face.

### No Cost

A student with more than two absences, repeated and/or serious disciplinary infractions will be <u>withdrawn</u>. Students are encouraged to complete the online *Credit Improvement Application* and return to their school counselor. The deadline for registering is **June 4, 2024**. Space is limited, so registration may not be taken after that time.

High School Credit Recovery and Credit Obtainment summer dates are (First Term: June 4 – June 27 and Second Term: July 1 – July 25, 2024).

Students should apply using the current *Credit Improvement Application* found on the SCHS website.

More than two (2) absences in a class may result in failure to earn credit. The principal must approve any additional absences. Although onsite class attendance is required, students may also arrange to work on assignments from home after class hours, if needed. All tests must be taken on the school campus.
