IV. SIT Draft Email Response

- a. On December 19, 2023, Councilmembers Nadeau and George requested a SIT. The Chancellor acknowledged receipt of the request. Alyssa Noth (intergovernmental affairs) replied on January 5, 2022 and said that there were regularly scheduled meetings every 6-8 weeks. Noth stated the next one will be held in mid-February.
- b. LSAT is still seeking clarification regarding modernization and renovation.
- c. LSAT does not acknowledge that the meeting held on December 21, 2022, does not qualify as a SIT.
