Helpful suggestions include: use the apps your child has, familiarize yourself with the ads that pop up and discuss strategies to deal with the marketing, look at who your child follows and who follows them, try a search inside the app to see if the results are appropriate, look for ways to enable content restrictions, review the need to report or block users who are unkind, learn how to turn off location settings, and reinforce that "temporary" pictures or videos, can be easily shared and stored.
