ORGANIZATION/SYNOPSIS OF LAW

O.C.G.A. 20-2-85 Establishment of School Councils

- **a.** The need to improve communication and participation of parents and the community in the management and operation of local schools.
- The management and control of public schools shall be the responsibility of local boards of education, and the school leader shall be the principal. School councils are advisory bodies.

O.C.G.A. 20-2-86 Requirements of School Councils

- **a.** Local Board of Education shall have school councils
- **D.** Local Board of Education shall provide training
- **C.** Resignation/removal of council members

INTENT OF SCHOOL COUNCILS

- BRING COMMUNITIES AND SCHOOLS TOGETHER I SPIRIT OF COOPERATION
- SOLVE DIFFICULT EDUCATION PROBLEMS
- IMPROVE ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
- PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS
- BRING PARENTS INTO THE SCHOOL-BASED DECISION-MAKING PROCESS
- ASSIST LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION DEVELOP PARTICIPATION
- CREATE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF AND MUTUAL RESPECT FOR EACH OTHER'S CONCERNS
- SHARE IDEAS FOR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM OF GA

- A+ EDUCATION REFORM ACT OF 2000
- ESTABLISHED THE CREATION OF SCHOOL COUNCILS
- MEMBERS OF SCHOOL COUNCILS ARE ACCOUNTABLE

ACCOUNTABILITY TO THE CONSTITUENTS

- MAINTAIN A SCHOOL-WIDE PERSPECTIVE ON ISSUES
- REGULARLY PARTICIPATE IN SCHOOL COUNCIL MEETINGS
- PARTICIPATE IN INFORMATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS
- ACT AS A LINK BETWEEN THE SCHOOL COUNCIL AND THE COMMUNITY
- ENCOURAGE THE PARTICIPATION OF PARENTS AND OTHERS WITHIN THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY
- WORK TO IMPROVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE



•WHO SERVES ON SCHOOL COUNCILS?

SCHOOL COUNCIL MEMBERS

- MINIMUM OF 7 MEMBERS
 - 4 PARENTS: AT LEAST 2 OF WHOM SHALL BE BUSINESSPERSONS; PARENTS MUST MAKE UP A MAJORITY OF THE SCHOOL COUNCIL
 - 2 TEACHERS
 - PRINCIPAL

TERMS

- TERM OF OFFICE IS 2 YEARS
- SHALL BE STAGGERED
 - MAY SERVE MORE THAN ONE TERM

VACATED

- RESIGNATION: SUBMIT A WRITTEN RESIGNATION TO THE COUNCIL AND COPY TO THE SCHOOL COUNCIL SECRETARY OR PRINCIPAL
 - IF A MEMBER HOLDING OFFICE IS REMOVED AS A MEMBER BY AN ACTION OF THE COUNCIL (INACTIVITY); OR
 - IF A MEMBER NO LONGER MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS SPECIFIED IN THE LAW (CHILD NO LONGER ATTENDS SCHOOL, RETIREMENT, MOVE, TRANSFER)

ELECTION/SELECTION OF MEMBERS

- PUBLIC NOTICE OF ELECTION
- PRINCIPAL SHALL CALL A MEETING
- ELECTING BODY CONSISTS OF ALL PARENTS AND GUARDIANS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS A
 PARENT MEMBER OF THE SCHOOL COUNCIL
- ELECTING BODY FOR TEACHER MEMBERS SHALL CONSIST OF ALL CERTIFICATED
 PERSONNEL ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS A TEACHER MEMBER OF THE SCHOOL COUNCIL
- WHEN THERE IS A VACANCY, ELECTIONS MUST OCCUR WITHIN 30 DAYS

OFFICERS

- CHAIRPERSON (PARENT)
- VICE-CHAIRPERSON
- SECRETARY
 - OFFICERS WILL BE ELECTED BY THE COUNCIL AT THE FIRST MEETING FOLLOWING THE ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS
 - PRINCIPAL CANNOT SERVE AS THE CHAIRPERSON NOR VICE-CHAIRPERSON

MEETINGS

- AT LEAST 4 MEETINGS ANNUALLY
- 4-7 MEMBERS MUST BE PRESENT
- ALL MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO PUBLIC

TRAINING

- LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE TRAINING
- TRAINING ADDRESSES
 - ORGANIZATION
 - PURPOSE
 - RESPONSIBILITIES
 - RULES & LAWS
 - REGULATIONS
 - PROCEDURES

AGENDA & MINUTES

- AGENDA
 - PRINCIPAL SETS THE AGENDA WITH CHAIRPERSON
 - USUALLY OCCURS AT THE END OF CURRENT MEETINGS FOR NEXT MEETING
- MINUTES
 - SECRETARY SHALL ATTEND ALL MEETINGS TO RECORD MINUTES
 - MINUTES ARE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC
