Cold/Flu/COVID season has hit us early this year!

Tips to keep your student healthy:
Drink plenty of water
Have nutritious meals
Dress appropriately for the weather
Plenty of sleep
Limit screen time, particularly at bedtime.
Frequent hand washing
Stay away from others that are ill

Keep your student home when he/she is sick! Please have a back up plan if your child needs to be picked up and you aren't available.



Should I keep my child home or send him or her to school?

School policy requests a child **stay home** if he or she:

Has a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher.

Keep your child home until his or her fever—100.4 or higher—has been gone for 24 hours <u>without</u> fever-reducing medication.

Has been vomiting or has diarrhea without a fever.

Keep your child home 24 hours after the last vomiting or diarrhea episode.

Has symptoms that keep him or her from participating in school, such as:

<u>Very</u> tired or lack of appetite.

Cough that he or she cannot control.

Shortness of breathe or difficulty breathing.

Moderate to severe headache, body aches, or earache.

Sore throat—a minor sore throat is ok for school, but a severe sore throat could be strep throat, even if there is no fever.

New loss of taste or smell.


