Meeting Minutes 8/8/2013

The Governing Board of the Tanque Verde Unified School District #13, Pima County, Tucson, Arizona held a Regular Session on August 8, 2013 in the Board Room, at the Tanque Verde Unified School District Administrative Office, 2300 N. Tanque Verde Loop Rd., Bldg. #1, and Tucson, Arizona 85749. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION: Mr. Auslander made a motion to approve the Agenda. Dr. Livingston seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

3. REPORTS

- Student Board Member Welcome TVHS Senior, Amanda Grimshaw was welcomed by the Board. Mrs. Place presented Amanda with the Student Board Member handbook. Amanda briefly addressed the board expressing her excitement and appreciation for being part of the Board. Amanda is on the high school swim team, a member of National Honor Society and Student Council, holding leadership positions in both organizations. Dr. Price asked Amanda to please attend the 1:00 Admin Meeting on Tuesday, August 13; this way she can meet the administrators she will be working with at the other campuses.
- Superintendent's Report Dr. Price announced TVUSD is ranked 9th in Arizona based on AIMS test scores (TVUSD is one of three traditional school districts in a tie for 9th with Ash Fork Joint Unified, and Glendale High School District).
 Dr. Price acknowledged SAIS Coordinator, Trish McCollom as being very instrumental in submitting timely and accurate student information reports to the Arizona Department of Education. In the SAIS Coordinator position Trish's attention to detail is critically

important as it directly relates to ADM for the district. Trish also makes sure we are prepared and ready for the auditors in September and December in all student information data from all the campuses. Mr. O'Shea agreed.

The TVES thermostats are being installed. Climatec is addressing the transitional issues being reported to Mr. O'Shea; Climatec should have them addressed/corrected by the end of the week.

Nicolas Barrios and Carlos Federico attended a training session in Phoenix with Climatec where they learned about the operation of the Building Automated Systems (BAS). Dr. Price mentioned the Maintenance Department converted a storage building into a classroom for use by Adaptive PE on the ACES campus. Dr. Price acknowledged our Maintenance Department, sharing with board members the talent we're fortunate to have in this department. Dr. Price encouraged Board members to stop by and see the room. Mrs. Place suggested we have a Board meeting at ACES in the near future.

➤ Charter Update – Progress is being made in receiving the CTDS number, which will allow the district to move forward with the Charter. Mr. O'Shea and Trish McCollom are working closely with their contacts at ADE.

Legislative update –

ASBA Legislative / State Budget – Board members discuss who would attend the legislative conference in September. Mrs. Place said she would attend and Dr. Price said he would attend as well.

• Facilities report –

➤ Climatec Update – The projects are progressing on each campus. The lighting systems in each room have been updated at the district office. Climatec will be at TVES next week. All of the 16 AC units arrived for installation at the TVES campus. Mr. O'Shea stated the projects are all on schedule and that he and Dr. Price continue to have weekly meetings with Nick Zehring from Climatec. Mr. O'Shea added that Mr. Brandon Woodward from Climatec will be at a future board meeting to answer questions.

Based on the discussions, the administrative recommendation is to approve a Primary tax rate of \$3.8031 and a Secondary tax rate of \$1.1981 which includes keeping the bond tax rate of \$.55 as promised to the voters.

MOTION: Dr. Livingston made a motion to approve the Tax Rates as submitted. Mr. Auslander seconded; the motion carried unanimously.
