Georgia Milestones Test-Taking Tips

You've Got This! Do Your Best!

Before Test Day

- Get a good night's sleep so your brain is ready to think.
- Eat a healthy breakfast to fuel your body.
- Arrive at school on time and ready to go.
- Bring a positive attitude—you can do hard things!

During the Test

- Read each question carefully—take your time.
- Look for important words and details in the question.
- Eliminate answers you know are incorrect.
- Choose the BEST answer, not just one that seems right.
- Watch out for “tricky” answers that may look correct but don't fully answer the question.
- Use your scratch paper to work out problems or jot down ideas.
- Check your work if you have time.

Stay Calm & Focused

- Take deep breaths if you feel nervous.
- Stay focused on your own test—do not worry about others.
- Keep going, even if a question feels difficult.
- Believe in yourself—you are prepared!
- Remember - we are proud of you!

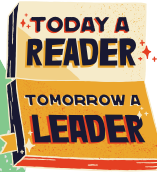
