



AP Statistics is a math course that relies on technology to solve problems from which the results are analyzed. Unlike traditional math courses, AP Statistics does not require students to use formulas or solve equations; instead, it presents real life questions that will need to be represented visually and recommendations made.

Statistics relies heavily on vocabulary and sentence frames, so know that taking this course will require you to learn new terminology.

Almost every major in college requires at least one statistics course, so this course is appropriate for all students.

The only prerequisite for AP Stats is a C or better in Algebra II. Also, AP Stats can be taken at the same time as Math Analysis or AP Calculus.

There is no summer assignment for statistics.
