

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List


**\*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.**

7th grade students will be taught the skills to be organized the first few days of school in English class. In order to do that, each 7<sup>th</sup> grade student *must have*:

- ❑ **1 – 1&1/2 inch to 2 inch binder**  
The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5-star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers can be especially useful. It is fine to get a standard binder, but you may end up needing to replace it within the year.
- ❑ **6 – different 3 hole punched folders that will fit in the binder**  
Poly type folders are recommended because they do not rip as easily. Do not label or write on any folders. Thin folders can be 3-hole punched if need. **Pronged folders cannot be used.**
- ❑ **1 - pencil box or bag to keep in locker for supplies** (a large Ziploc works)
- ❑ **2 - packages loose leaf paper, wide ruled or college ruled.**
- ❑ **1 - BASIC calculator (\$1 type).** Scientific calculators are **not** used in 7<sup>th</sup> grade.

### **And**

- ❑ Pencils (standard or mechanical with extra lead)
- ❑ Erasers (often pink)
- ❑ Hi-liters (2 colors)
- ❑ Colored Pencils (minimum 10 in box)
- ❑ Bag/backpack



## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

**\*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.**

Each 8<sup>th</sup> grade student must have:


- ☐ Pencils
  - ☐ 3-ring Binder (1½ in to 2 in) **plus** loose leaf paper.
- OR**
- ☐ 2 notebooks – 3- to 5- subject **plus** a 1” 3-ring binder for **English class only**.

*If their 7<sup>th</sup> grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!*

- ☐ 2 to 6 – different 3-hole punched folders.  
Get at least 2 folders. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.
- ☐ 1 – pencil box or bag for supplies
- ☐ 1 – calculator. Scientific calculators may be used 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade

And

- ☐ Erasers



## 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Supplies

- ☐ Pencils
- ☐ 3-ring Binder (1½ in to 2 in) with **plenty** of loose-leaf paper.

**OR**


- ☐ 2 notebooks – 3- to 5- subject  
**plus** a 1” 3-ring binder for **English class only**.

*If their 8<sup>th</sup> grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!*

- ☐ 2 to 6 – different 3-hole punched folders.  
Get at least 2. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.
- ☐ 1 – pencil box or bag for supplies
- ☐ 1 – calculator. Scientific calculators may be used 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Optional:

- ☐ Pens – only black/blue pens are permitted for assignments
- ☐ Hi-liters
- ☐ Colored Pencils
- ☐ Markers
- ☐ Compass
- ☐ Protractor
- ☐ Bag/Backpack



## 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

**\*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.**

Each 10<sup>th</sup> grade student must have:

- ☐ Pencils
- ☐ 3-ring Binder (1½ in to 2 in) with **plenty** of loose-leaf paper.

**OR**


- ☐ 2 notebooks – 3- to 5- subject
  - plus a 1 in 3-ring binder for **English class only**.

*If their 9<sup>th</sup> grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!*

- ☐ 2 to 6 – different 3-hole punched folders.  
Get at least 2. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.
- ☐ 1 – pencil box or bag for supplies
- ☐ 1 – calculator. Scientific calculators may be used 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade  
Graphing calculators are only used in advanced math classes – if you are not sure what you'll need, ask your teacher before buying.
- ☐ Compass (for geometry)
- ☐ Protractor (for geometry)

- ☐ Hi-liters
- ☐ Colored Pencils
- ☐ Markers
- ☐ Bag/Backpack



# 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

**\*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.**

Each student must have:

- ☐ Pencils
- ☐ Paper – a binder with enough loose-leaf paper, **OR** enough lined notebooks for the year.
- ☐ Folders – at least 1 for minimum organization.  
(Even if notebooks have folders in them, they will quickly overflow)
- ☐ Calculator. If you are unsure if you need a graphing calculator, please ask your teacher before buying.

Optional:

- ☐ Binder
- ☐ Pens
- ☐ Hi-liters
- ☐ Colored Pencils
- ☐ Markers
- ☐ Bag/Backpack
- ☐ Container for supplies (to keep in the locker)

Mrs. Sherbrooke will have current event forms, paper and cutter for flashcards, and labels for organization for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students.
