

# Kindergarten Supply List

- Backpack
- (4) pencils, sharpened
- (1) Blue plastic folder
- (**2 Packs**) Crayons - 8-count only
- (**2 Packs**) Markers – 8- or 10-count
- (6) Large glue sticks
- (1) Large pink eraser
- Pointed child scissors
- Headphones for computer class - Please put in a Ziploc bag with your name on it.
- A box or bag of crackers/cookies for the whole class to share during milk break. (We don't have our own snacks, we share.)
- An old shirt to be used as a paint shirt for Art
- Tennis shoes for Phy. Ed.
- A towel for rest time - no blankets - They will be used on top of rest mats.
- One change of clothes – shirt, pants, underwear, socks – in a Ziploc bag with name.

# 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Supply List

- Backpack - one without wheels

- (2) boxes – 24 count crayons (please leave in boxes)
- 10- or 12-count washable markers
- (2) bottles 4 oz. liquid glue (check label for "school glue" - it works best)
- (2) large glue sticks
- Safety scissors appropriate size for your child's hand
- (1) COMPOSITION notebook (NOT spiral bound. Look for composition on the label)
- (1) standard size pencil box
- (10) wood pencils (no mechanical please)
- (1) box pencil top erasers (please leave in box)
- (1) family size box of Kleenex
- Tennis shoes with non-marking soles for Phy Ed.  
(Please consider non-lacing shoes or make sure your child masters tying laces)
- Headphones for computers
- Old button front shirt to wear while painting

Make sure initials are on all items (including crayons and markers). Please only send items indicated on the list and do not send larger sizes than listed. Extra things like pencil sharpeners, notebooks, highlighters, pens, etc. are not necessary and will be sent home. Items such as glue and pencils may need to be resupplied throughout the year, so please make sure to purchase extra while back to school sales are on and store at home. Please do not send the extras to school as we do not have the storage space. Make sure you have crayons at home for homework as well.

# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

- (1) Binder – 1½” to 2” (The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5-star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers can be especially useful. It is fine to get a standard binder, but if you buy a durable one, you will be able to use it again in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. If you bought one in 5<sup>th</sup> grade, feel free to use it again.)
- (5) 3-hole punched folders that will fit in the binder (I recommend the poly type folders because they do not rip as easily at the binder rings. The pronged folders **cannot** be used.)
- (2) 1-subject notebooks: Journal – Yellow, Math – Blue
- Pencils and Erasers
- Pens
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue Stick
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Pack of highlighters (I recommend a 5-pack with colors such as yellow, pink, blue, green, and orange.)
- Full size box of Kleenex
- Headphones in a Ziploc bag
- Water bottle (optional)
- Tennis Shoes used only for Phy Ed.

*The school will supply an academic planner, so please don't purchase one.*



## Hankinson High School 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supply List

Each student **must** have:

- **One 1.5 inch to 2 inch binder**  
The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5-Star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers are especially useful for students who struggle with organization. It is fine to get a more standard binder.
- **Six different 3-hole punched folders** that will fit in the binder  
We recommend the poly type folders because they do not rip as easily at the binder rings. Please wait to label or write on any folders. Labels will be given at school. No pronged folders.
- **Black 1 inch binder** for English
- **Pencil box or bag** to keep in locker for supplies
- **Loose leaf paper or notebooks** with perforated edges (wide ruled or college ruled)
- **Calculator**
  - 7<sup>th</sup> Grade – Standard five-function calculator
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade – Scientific calculator (not graphing calculator)
- **Pencils**
- **Erasers**

Optional:

- **Colored pencils**
- **Bag/backpack** (students are not allowed to carry to classes)
- **Thin expo markers and cloth** for eraser



## Hankinson High School 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supply List

Each student **must** have:

- **Pencils**
