SCHOOL BOARD LEGISLATIVE INVOLVEMENT

The Board, as an agent of the State, must operate within the bounds of state and federal law affecting public education. If the Board is to meet its responsibilities to the residents and students of the community, it must work for the passage of laws designed to advance the cause of good schools and for the repeal or modification of existing laws that impede this cause.
