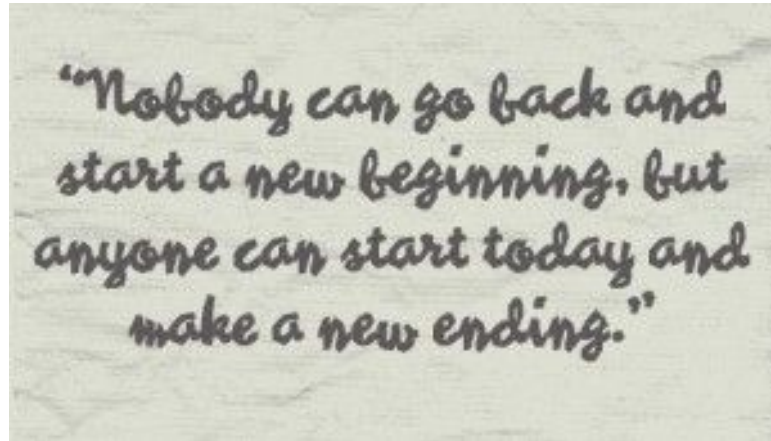

WHAT DOES AVID LOOK LIKE AND SOUND LIKE?

The AVID curriculum, based on rigorous standards, was developed by middle and senior high school teachers in collaboration with college professors. It is driven by the WICOR method, which stands for writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization and reading. AVID curriculum is used in AVID classes, in content-area classes in AVID schools, and even in schools where AVID is not offered.

Tutorial support

Motivational activities

HOW WILL AVID BE IMPLEMENTED?

All staff members will be attending training this summer and incorporating AVID strategies and techniques into their classroom.

The AVID teacher supports students by teaching organizational skills, study and test taking skills, and critical reading and writing strategies needed for school success and post-secondary plans. The AVID teacher will monitor student progress in their other classes and provide support in their rigorous coursework.



AVID REQUIREMENTS:

All students will be required to bring their three ring binder (provided by the district) to all of their classes.

Note-taking(Cornell Notes)will be a daily expectation for both students and staff.

Students will Write, make Inquiries, Collaborate, be **O**rganized, and Read (**WICOR**).

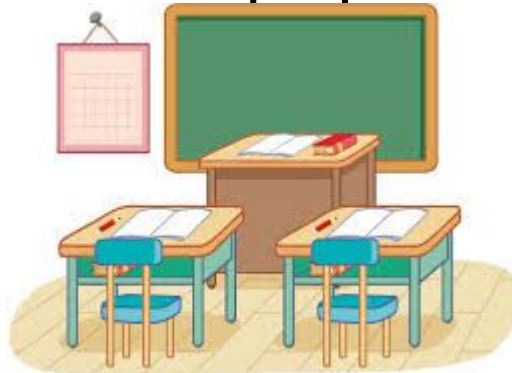

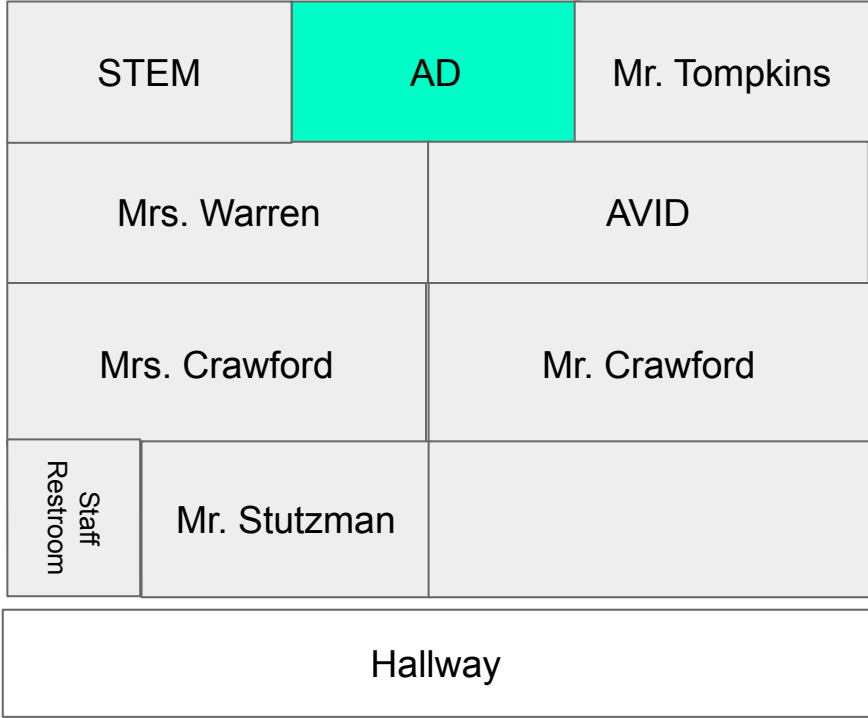
