

Pricing is to be delivered mark-up over the daily OPIS (Oil Price Information Services) PAD 2 average price. Mark-up should include freight and profit, and the base OPIS price will be subject to verification, upon request, at any time and for any delivery. Copy of the OPIS report for the requested day must be provided upon this verification request. The Livingston County Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

- Gasoline- 89 octane unleaded plus gasoline \_\_\_\_\_ over daily OPIS avg. price.  
Please do not include taxes, only price per gallon.
- Motor Oil- Chevron Ursa Super Plus EC SAE 15W-40  
Bulk price per gallon.
- Diesel- High sulfur (off-road) #2 diesel \_\_\_\_\_ over daily OPIS average price; to be delivered to Livingston Central High School, Livingston County Middle, North and South Livingston Elementaries.  
Low sulfur (on-road) #2 diesel \_\_\_\_\_ over daily OPIS average price to be delivered to LCMS (in Burna) and the bus garage in Smithland. Please do not include taxes, only price per gallon.
- Propane- Priced by gallon, to be delivered as needed upon request to the Livingston County Middle School, South Elementary, Livingston Central High School, and the bus garage. (bidder must furnish and check tanks).
