Dance Tickets: Monday, August 26th – Monday, September 16th. Students MUST turn in their conduct forms and complete the Google Form <u>PRIOR</u> to purchasing tickets <u>online</u>. Students must pay for their ticket by Monday, September 16th. Tickets may be limited to ensure we have our required chaperones, so students should purchase tickets early. Tickets are: \$25 per ticket. JPII students may purchase 1 additional guest ticket. <u>Outside guests are required to complete a code of conduct form and have their school submit an outside guest approval form.</u>

Dance attire: Please make sure you review the Dance Attire and Dress code in the Code of Conduct. Students are expected to be clean and neat in their personal appearance, and observing standards of modesty and Christian morality. Parents of a student whose attire does not meet the guidelines as determined by the chaperones will be contacted to bring an appropriate outfit that meets the requirements. We want to make this a joyful and memorable event for all students; therefore, we strongly encourage students to bring a picture of themselves in their semi-formal wear for approval prior to the dance to Mrs. Whetstone.

Code of Conduct:

Students need to print the Code of Conduct that must be signed by the student AND parent.

All outside dates/students must have an <u>additional form faxed from their school to JPII</u> in addition to the <u>Code of Conduct</u>. The form must be FAXED or EMAILED by the school that completes the form.

All <u>Code of Conduct</u> forms are due by **Monday, September 16th** and students will receive tickets the week of Homecoming.

Spirit Week: Throughout Spirit Week there will be competitions. The winner will be announced at the Homecoming Pep Rally on **Friday, September 20th**.

During Spirit Week leading up to Homecoming (Sept. 16th – Sept. 20th), our students will dress up according to each theme or come to school in UNIFORM.

House points will be awarded for students that participate in the theme days.
