Thank you to Frank's Plumbing for the installation of the heat pumps at St. Edward. This week, too, we should see the start (and hopefully completion) of the installation of the new sound system at St. Eloi. This project had been delayed due to the limited availability of the components needed. It will be wonderful when this is done – perhaps more will be able to hear clearly wherever they sit in the church.

In the not-so-distant future, we will be installing new windows in the sacristy at St. Ed's. They are drafty and difficult to open. Due to the recent storms, we will also need to replace the roof of the KC Hall. We received a generous donation specified for roofs, and with the mild damage we sustained, it seems fitting to use it for this project. We are also awaiting the arrival and installation of the louvers for the St. Ed's church steeple.

CAN YOU HELP US STUFF THE BUS?

The purpose of our Stuff the Bus initiative is to provide basic school supplies to LOCAL K-12 students to help them learn and be successful, thereby allowing them (and their parents) to focus on their academic goals. YOU can be a part of this!

All collected supplies will be distributed to participating schools within the UWSWMN service area. Because of this initiative, 56,250 school supplies were distributed in August 2021 to approximately 3,500 students at 23 local school schools. Each school determines their own distribution process to ensure the supplies reach students who need them. Supplies will be sorted and distributed on August 10, and those in need of supplies should contact their respective school district beginning on August 12 for details regarding distribution.

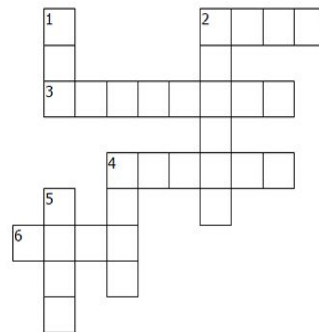
