Dear Frazier Parent/ Guardian:

In reflecting on the tragedy that took place in Tennessee this week, and the swatting calls that occurred across our region today, I wanted to write to ask for your assistance. In order for our schools to be as safe as possible, it important to have an open line of communication between the district and the home. We cannot investigate an incident or threat that takes place outside of the school day if we are unaware that it occurred. School safety is a community effort.

I encourage all parents, teachers, and students to be observant of your surroundings. Anything that you feel jeopardizes the safety of our students or district, needs to be reported to a school official, or law enforcement so that they can determine if the threat is credible.

Also, please be reminded that school employees are not permitted to divulge student information to anyone other than the parent/ guardian of that student, this includes student discipline. Rest assured, if there is a student infraction, it will be vetted and handled according to district policy.

As the Superintendent of Schools, and more importantly a father with two sons of my own, I know the importance of a safe and secure learning environment and I assure you that every member of the Frazier School Community works to ensure the same. I have attached a document that can assist in speaking to your child about school violence: <u>Talking to Children</u> <u>about Violence</u>. Through communication and teamwork, we can build upon the safety and security measures that are currently in place.
